The CAPTCHA page

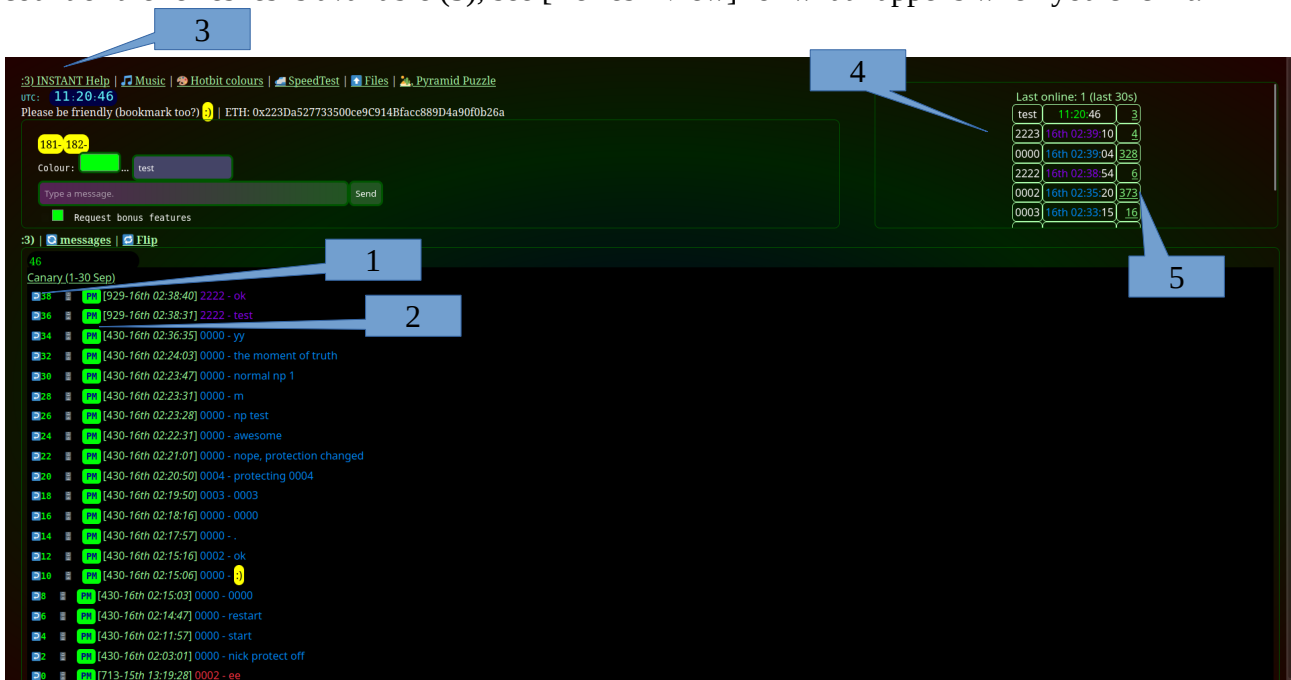
When you enter the chat, you will see the CAPTCHA page. A prompt is displayed (1), along with the SVG challenge (2). Solve it (3), enter a nick (4), and clicking “Enter with Audio” (5) or “Enter without Audio” (5), will give you Entry to the chat.

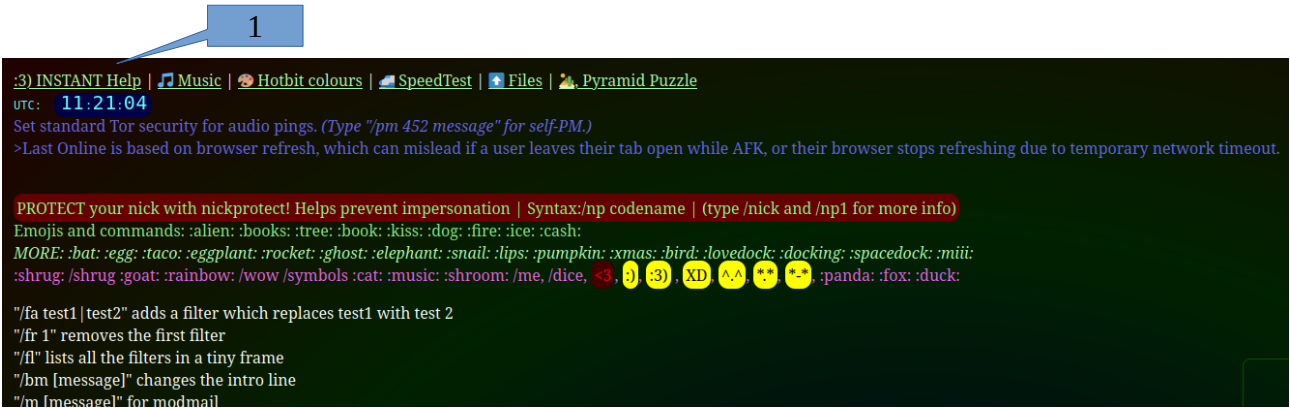
Before entering, You can also customise the colour by clicking (6), picking a colour, and clicking select (7). The appearance will vary based on OS.

The Chat page

Below is where all the action happens, if you have entered a nickname, it will be shown. In the box called “type a message” you can type a message, and click send to send. If there is “Unknown Error”, refresh the page.

You can also Quote (1) or Private Message (2) another user. For more help, click “Instant Help”. (3) The Last Online List (4) shows whoever visited recently, and the last time the server saw them. A count of the refreshes is available (5), see [Refresh View] for what happens when you click it.

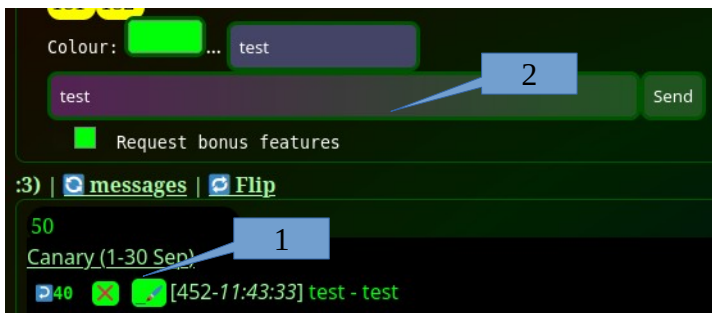




Advanced

The Instant Help menu shows more instructions, click the link (1) to hide. There is also a clock too, in blue, as well as more links to explore.

In the Screenshot below, users can edit their message (1). Clicking the button brings up the old message for editing (2)

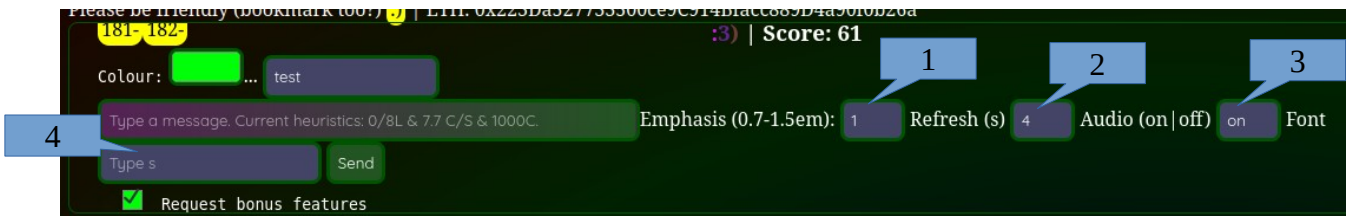


Requesting Bonus features

Users have the ability to get the system to show more features, by first checking the checkbox (1), and then clicking Send (2). Repeating this action disables the bonus features.



This will bring up a screen showing 4 bonus features: Emphasis (1), which adjust's the font size of the user's message, from tiny [0.7] to large [1.5]. The refresh rate can be set (2), just like in the CAPTCHA page. Even the audio notifications (3) can be turned on/off by typing "on" or "off". Finally, type "s" to reveal a list of fonts. Once happy with the changes, click "Send" (with or without a message)



Refresh View

Clicking link (5) on the Chat page (2nd image from top of page) leads to an analytics screen, showing user creation date, and the times their browser refreshed, combined with the colour choices they chose and the entry/exit times mixed in. Clicking the previous/next buttons (2) can sometimes show more refresh records
